We will continue to learn Jesus' parables which teach us about caring from others as well as learning stories from the Old Testament (Jewish stories)

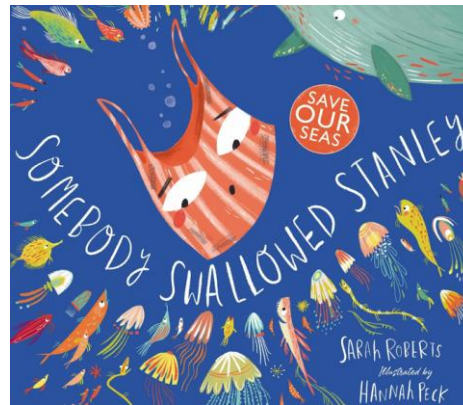
Geography: The Oceans of the world

This half term we will be focussing on the oceans of the world. We will understand the difference between a sea (close to land) and an ocean (away from land) and use the Equator, North and South Pole to locate them. We will use Atlases and globes to identify them on a map. We will understand the human impact on the oceans and the damage this is doing to the world's marine life.

DT:

We will be creating a puppet theatre using a shoe box to create an underwater scene to support our text of Somebody Swallowed Stanley.

We will create moving parts for underwater creatures and use different ways of attaching techniques.

Science

We will be looking at how plants grow in the summer and compare this with growth during winter and spring. We also have a fun unit around growing and cooking.
