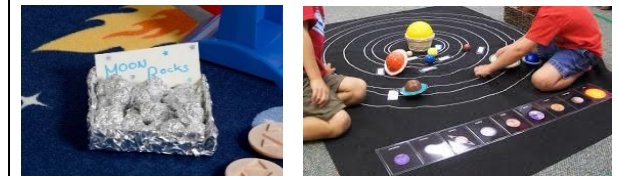
Snowman bananas
