

Here are some simple activities you can do at home to support your child's learning...

Day	Activity
Mark Making Monday 	Using paint brushes, rollers, leaves tied together etc and water outside. - what patterns can you make? - Can you write a 'l' or a number 1, draw a rectangle? 
Talking Tuesday 	Practise singing Row, Row, Row your boat
Wellness Wednesday 	Take 1 minute to take a few deep breaths in and out.
Thirst for Knowledge Thursday 	Find out different ways to be kind to others. - can you ask people in your family or friends at home?
Fidgety Friday 	Kick a ball around in the park, in the garden or play catch.

This half term our PSHE (Jigsaw) topic is **Being Me in My World** and our School values are Respect, Resilience and Responsibility, which are being learnt and supported all through the year. However we will be focusing on **Respect** this term.
