




Here are some simple activities you can do at home to support your child's learning...

Thirst for Knowledge Thursday 	Create a family tree. Do all your family members live in Nottingham? 
Fidgety Friday 	Learn how to play hopscotch




This week we will be starting our focus book. It is called 'Dear Zoo' by Rod Campbell, which is fun and interactive. The children love seeing what animal is in the box!
