

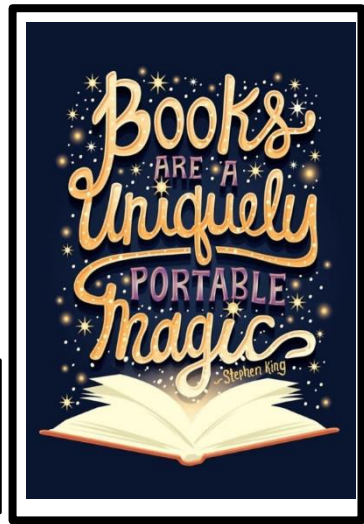

Lillian from 2b says:

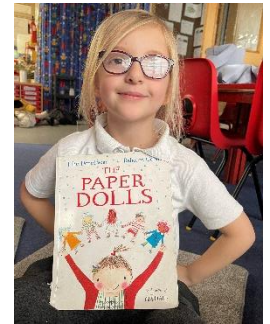
"This is one of my favourite books at the minute – the girl in it goes on an adventure!"
