Readathon

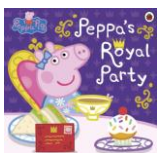
The support for the 'Readathon' has been overwhelming. We have raised a HUGE **£992.30** for a very worthy cause. Thank you for all your support.



The Queen's Jubilee

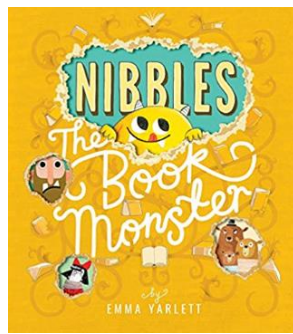

Mrs Elkington – Nibbles the Book Monster by Emma Yarlett



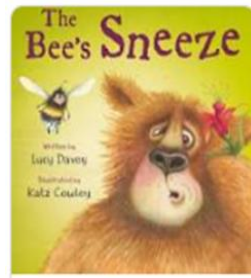
I was recently introduced to this book and I absolutely love it!

Nibbles is a very naughty book monster – he's chomping, munching and nibbling his way through fairy tales that don't belong to him! You will love to lift the flaps, peek through the peep holes, and chase Nibbles through a fantastical world of books.

I really like that this is a quirky story which is exquisitely illustrated by Emma Yarlett. It's Jam-packed full of all of my favourite fairy tales including Little Red Riding Hood, Jack and the Beanstalk and Goldilocks and the Three Bears.
